- MAKE APPLICATION  
Complete the application, obtain patrol director's recommendation and submit to Division OEC Supervisor. Also – register on NSP web site.

Verify time and location and ensure all registration details are completed for participation in the evaluation.

- OBTAIN CURRENT CARDS  
Make sure you have a current NSP membership card and current OEC card. If you do not have current cards obtain them from NSP. Due: Feb 9 2018
  
- TRAINING SESSIONS  
Schedule training activities with patrol director or OEC training coordinator.

Complete 2 written scenario exercises (from Ski Patroller's Manual beginning page 184). Due: Feb 9 2018
  
- WRITE 1 ORIGINAL SROEC SCENARIO  
Complete 1 written SROEC Scenario utilizing the Scenario Scoring Matrix. Due: Feb 9 2018
  
- ON-THE-SNOW SCENARIOS  
Satisfactorily complete at least 4 senior practical scenarios on the snow & obtain OEC IT or OEC Instructor sign-off on OEC Basic Skills Performance Check-Off Form. Due: Feb 9 2018
  
- IDENTIFY PATIENT AND PROVIDE CONTACT INFORMATION TO DIVISION OEC  
Establish who will serve as your volunteer patient for the day of final evaluation. Provide patient's name & contact information to the Division OEC Supervisor or SROEC Training Coordinator as applicable.

- PREPARE FOR FINAL EVALUATION  
Arrange for equipment to be brought to the site. Bring skis, patrol belt and appropriate clothing.
